# QUALIFICATIONS

- Must hold a FAA Mechanic Certificate with Airframe and Powerplant ratings.
- Must have and maintain a valid Driver's License, with a clean driving record.
- Ability to pass a 10-year criminal history check.
- Must have a high school diploma, or GED.
- Good communication skills, reliable, and self-motivated .
- Exercise good judgement in working within a team environment as well as in aircraft maintenance and safety.
- Willingness to travel and work weekends, holidays, and night shift.
- U.S. Citizen or have authorization to work in the United States.
- Physical requirements.
- Pre-employment Drug Test.



# Overview of Training

- Initial paid training program (Indoc) – 3 weeks in Indianapolis
  - Systems overview; GMM and reference; RAMCO; 10-hr OSHA Certification, Two days of OJT
- Airfare, hotel, and ground transportation to training provided
- Per Diem on first paycheck, unless your base is in Indianapolis
- Company Orientation provided by HR department
- Fingerprint screening on Day 1
- All Technicians are issued an iPad

# Maintenance Military Transition Program

- Approx. 200,000 service members each year enter the civilian world
- Less than \*\*10% of veterans\*\* with aviation maintenance experience transition into civilian aviation roles due to the complexity of certification pathways and regulatory requirement
- The Military Maintenance Transition Program is to help veterans and service members transition from military work to civilian work

- Study sessions on nights/weekends will necessary to ensure successful completion of the class

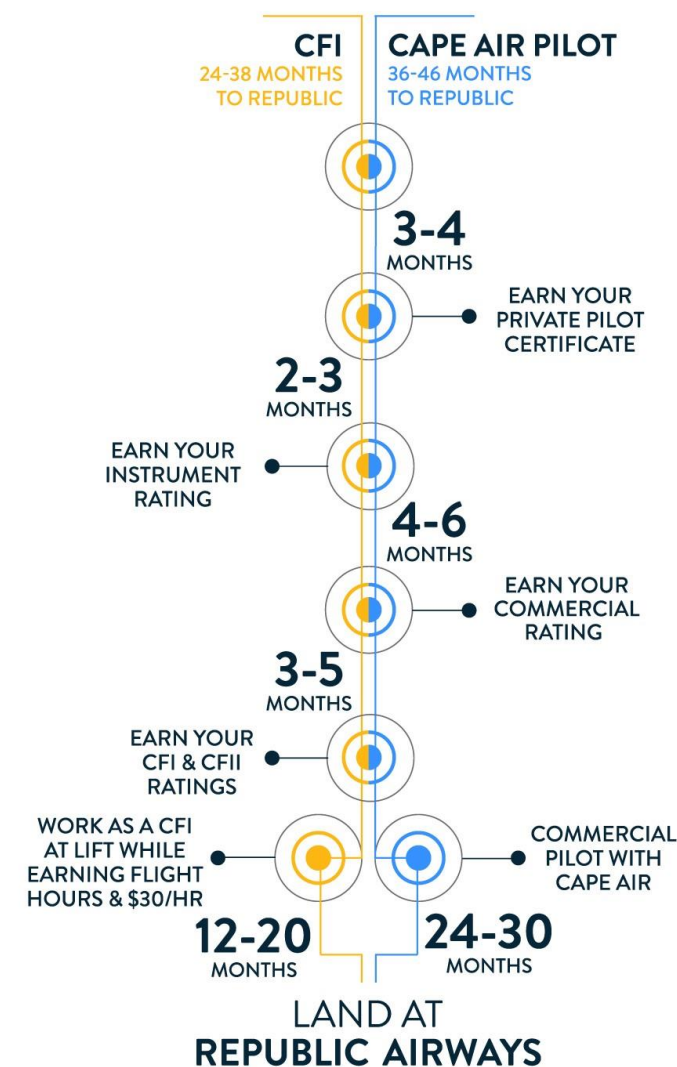
